LAS VEGAS PAIUTE GOLF CLUB SNOW MOUNTAIN COURSE

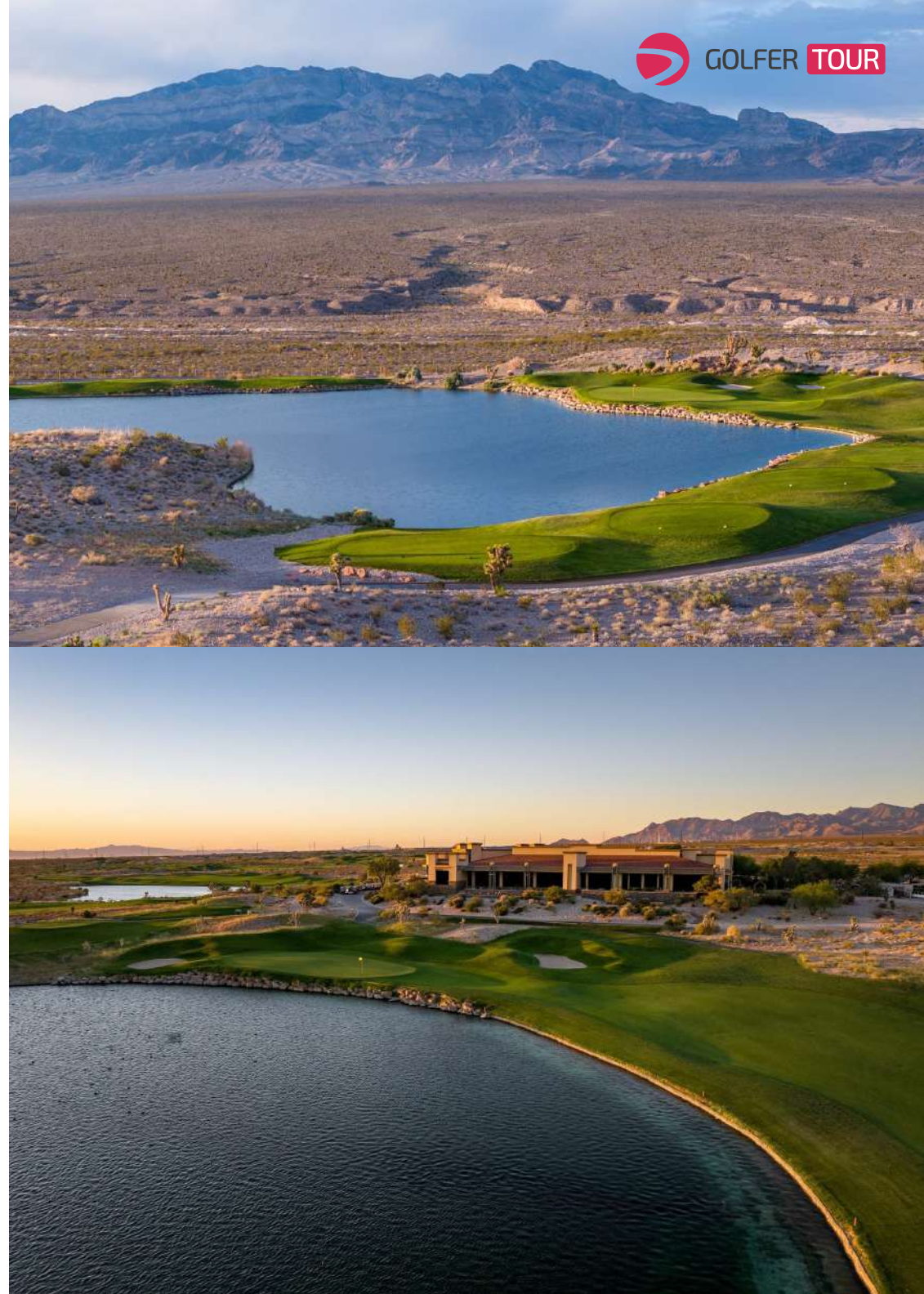
Just 25 minutes northwest of the famed Las Vegas Strip, this international golf destination is serving up the ultimate trio of magnificent, championship golf courses.

Snow Mountain is Paiute's original course and storms in at 7,146 total yards from the professional tees. The Pete Dye design is challenging but enjoyable with memorable water features, dog legs, bunkers and pure greens, our regulars feel Snow Mountain is the best of the three.

Both holes 7 and 13 offer a chance to go for the green from the tee — by carrying a series of bunkers and a desert waste, respectively — but that doesn't mean golfers should. This design strategy keeps scoring possibilities equal for those of lesser distance, even if the overall yardage seems short.

COYOTE SPRINGS GOLF COURSE

Situated an hour's drive north of Las Vegas, the course at Coyote Springs Golf Club is a Jack Nicklaus layout with fairways routed around eleven man-made lakes in a harsh, rugged landscape, with native desert areas to be carried from many of the tees.

Since opening in 2008, Coyote Springs is considered by most to be Jack's finest desert creation! The course plays to a par 72 and ranges from 5,349 yards from the forward tees to 7,471 yards from the championship tees.

Coyote Springs has been rated by Golf Digest in the 'Top 100 Greatest Public Courses' and Golf Magazine's & Golfweek Magazine's 'Top Places You Can Play'.

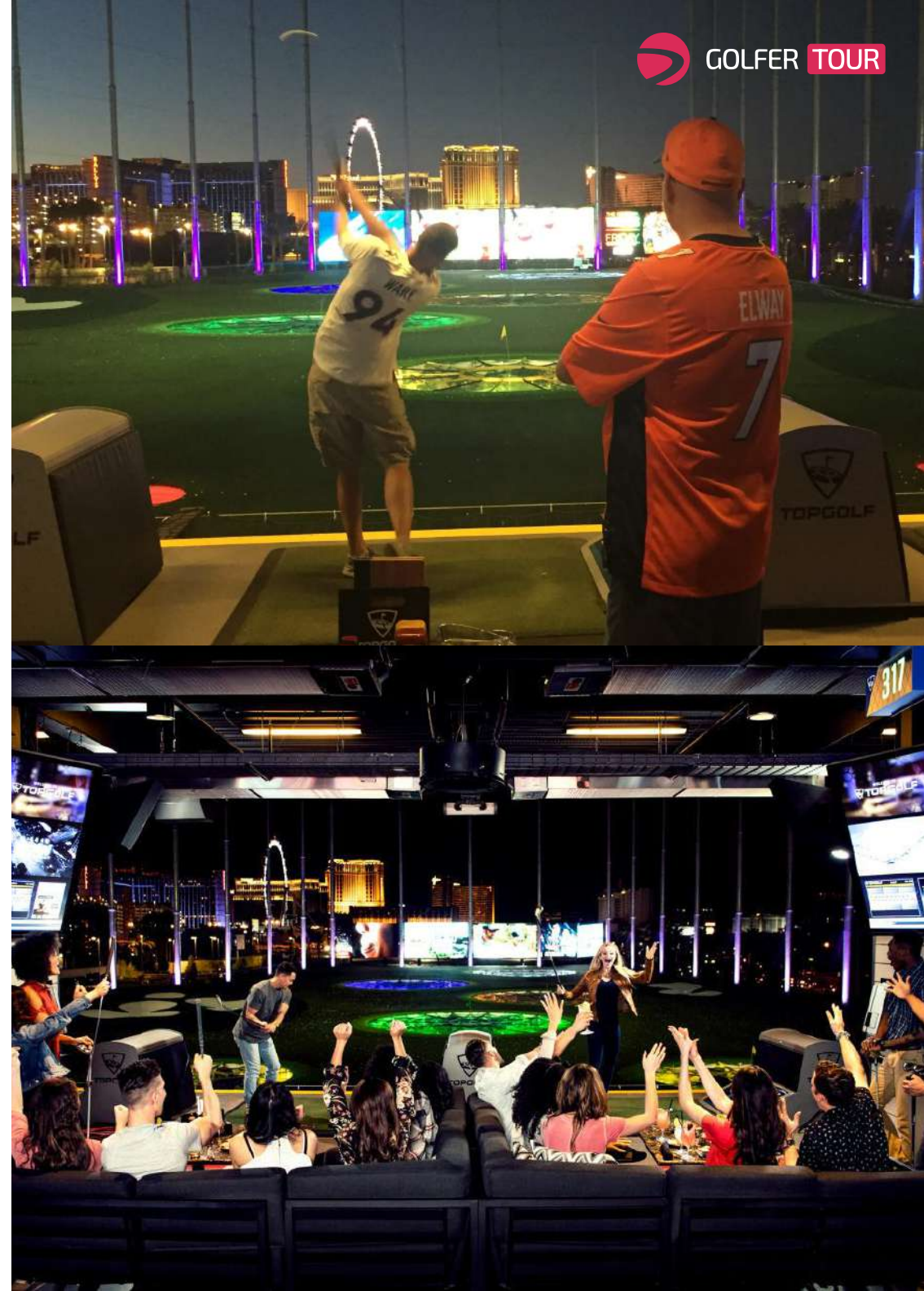
WELCOME PARTY

TIPS FOR VISITING LAS VEGAS

Bring warm clothes

Average daily temperatures are 22C and as low as 4C overnight. Expect it to be fresh on the golf course and at night.

You don't have to gamble

Not a gambler? Not a problem! There are tons of other fun things to do and see in Las Vegas.

Don't miss downtown!

Downtown Las Vegas is home to a number of attractions, including Fremont Street, which boasts an LED-covered walkway, zipline, and numerous museums and attractions! There are also casinos downtown, and they're often cheaper than the casinos on the Strip.

Be cab savvy

If you're planning on taking a cab anywhere in Las Vegas, be prepared to leave at least an extra half an hour to find an empty cab, or even more if you're travelling between 6 and 8 PM. Cabs are also not allowed to pick up customers on the Strip. If you want to catch a cab, you'll have to grab one at a resort.

ATMS are really expensive

The standard fee is \$5.99, so make sure you bring all the cash you think you'll need!

Can't make it to the Canyon?

We would recommend a visit to the The Sphere, a revolutionary venue to enjoy immersive shows, concerts, and events like never before.

There's no dress code!

Think Vegas is all tuxedos and sky-high heels? Think again! The fancier clubs may require you to dress up, but there's no dress code on the Strip. You'll see people dressed to the nines right alongside people in cargo shorts, running shoes, and Hawaiian shirts.

Don't overpay for drinks

In an effort to keep you gambling (and spending money), casinos offer free drinks to anyone playing the slots or table games. So instead of heading straight for the bar, take a seat and wait for a server to come to you. Just be sure to tip so your server keeps coming back.
